### A. CALL TO ORDER

#### B. INVOCATION

Coun. Shealy delivered the invocation.

#### C. PUBLIC INFORMATION

It is noted by the Clerk herein that in compliance with the Freedom of Information Act, notice of the called meeting and agenda were given to the local news media and properly posted, to include the county website.

#### D. NEW BUSINESS

 Chm. Jones recognized Risk Manager Hardee Horne and Public Buildings Supervisor Kent Long to present consideration for replacement of the hot water heater at the Saluda County Detention Center.

Mr. Horne gave an overview of the deteriorating condition of the water heater, parts, and outflow line that supplies the kitchen and female showers at the Detention Center and expressed concern of damages to the facility if the tank and outflow line ruptured. Mr. Long reviewed three models of water heater systems and quotes as provided by Derrick Plumbing Inc. Mr. Long and Mr. Horne recommended the Rinnai tankless, triple heater rack system, the most cost effective, at a cost of \$11,130.00 which included material, labor and equipment to replace the existing PVI water heater. Mr. Long said boiler inspections would not be required with the tankless system and could easily be relocated to a new

facility. Mr. Long informed Council any electrical connections would need to be performed by an electrician.

On motion of Coun. Shealy, seconded by Coun. Daniel, it was unanimously approved to purchase a Rinnai tankless, triple heater rack system in the amount of \$11,130.00 as quoted from Derrick Plumbing Inc., along with electrical cost, to be paid from the Jail Renovations account.

On motion of Coun. Miller, seconded by Coun. Shealy, it was unanimously approved to adjourn the meeting at 5:55 P.M.
