NEW COMMERCIAL CONSTRUCTION

- 1. Permit application
- 2. Site Plan Survey showing all setbacks, structure location and 100-year flood plain (if applicable).
- 3. Set of Engineered / Architect stamped Construction and Civil Plans (PDF Preferred)
- 4. Set of fire alarm and sprinkler plans if applicable
- 5. A copy of GC and all Sub-Contractor License and contact info
- 6. A copy of DHEC Permit to Construct

<u>SIGNS</u>

- 1. Permit application
- 2. Set of plans showing
 - a. Footing details
 - b. Height of sign and mounting information
- 4. All setbacks must be indicated on the plans.
- 5. You must have all above documents submitting plans for review.
- 6. Plan reviews take up to 5 business days, please have a valid email address as that is the best form of contact.

Chapter 6 – Buildings & Building Regulations

Section 6-7 - Distance & Setback Requirements.

No structure shall be located closer than 25 feet to the right-of-way of a street or closer than 20 feet from another structure. All structures must have a minimum setback of ten feet from property lines.
